

Please follow these guidelines for community living with your dog here in the Carillon House.

- Documented, Support, Companion and Therapy dogs are allowed entrance/exit through any door. Please put a bright collar on your therapy dog to identify it as such (e.g. orange). All other dogs are to enter and exit via the north garage only.
- The one exception to this entrance rule is when you take your dog out the back door of the building (near the north garage) for a short walk in our "back yard".
- Just inside the north garage door are bags to pick up your dog's waste. Please consider taking an extra bag and picking up some extra waste!
- Bags of waste can be disposed of in the dumpsters in the north garage near the car wash.
- When using washers and dryers please clean up any dog hair left behind.

- If your dog has an accident on the elevator, or anyplace in the building, it is your responsibility to clean it up. Feel free to use the cleaning supplies located on the shelf outside the North garage entrance to the elevators.
- Dogs should always be on a leash in our building and on our property.
- Aggressive dog's should always be muzzled and controlled by their owners. You are responsible for your dog's behavior.
- When using the elevator with your dog, please stand back when others are entering/exiting the elevator. And use caution when getting on and off the elevator with your dog.
- Please make sure you report to the Carillon House Board of Directors any "aggressive dog behavior". Please see the rules about "aggressive dog behavior" first.
