Please receive this letter in acknowledgement of your March 25, 2020 letter regarding the Carillon House Association. The Miami Valley Fair Housing Center (MVFHC) disagrees with the assessment that there is any confusion on the Fair Housing Center's part regarding what the Carillon House Association has done already to violate the Fair Housing Act. The Fair Housing Center believes that the Carillon House Association Board's response is recalcitrant and exacerbates confusion among the residents of Carillon House about their individual Fair Housing Rights.

We respectfully disagree with a number of points in your March 25, 2020 letter and are unwilling to continue parsing words on such a very basic concept in the protections afforded people with disabilities under the Fair Housing Act. The Fair Housing Center has attempted to provide clear guidance to the Carillon House Association Board regarding this matter in an attempt to resolve it. Given that we remain in disagreement, the Fair Housing Center will consider the appropriate enforcement action to pursue.
